




Pt. Mohan Lal S.D. College for Girls, Fatehgarh Churian was founded in 2005 to immortalize the memory of revered Late Dr. Pt. 

GUIDELINES REQUIREMENTS & ELIGIBILTY FOR ADMISSION



- A candidate seeking admission to the college is required to fulfill the following requirements:-
- 1. The prescribed admission form and a copy of the college prospectus for 2024-2025 sessions can be obtained from the college office on payment of Rs. 250.
- 2. A student is required to fill up all particulars in her own handwriting. The prescribed admission form which should be complete in all respects and a latest passport size photograph should be affixed on the specified space. The student is also required to put her signature on the photograph.
- 3. Incomplete form will be rejected.
- 4. The following certificates/documents must be attached with the Admission Form:

 - Character /School leaving certificate from the Head of the institution last attended.
 - Migration and eligibility certificate if the candidate has passed lower examination from University/ Board other than G.N.D.U. of Punjab School Education Board. Such Students are required to get eligibility from G.N.D.U. at their own level before seeking admission.
 - In case of a Schedule Caste (SC) or Backward Class (BC), a certificate from the competent authority along with Income Certificate and Domicile Certificate should be attached.
 - · Copy of Aadhaar card.
 - Passport size photographs of Father and Mother.
 - NCC/NSS/Sports certificate for weightage, wherever applicable.
 - Bonafied resident of Punjab certificate, if applicable.
 - · Gap year affidavit, if applicable.
 - Rural Area/Border Area certificate if applicable.
- 4. Failed/detained/Absent Students from any other college/University exam will not be admitted in the college in any case.
- 5. Compartment cases from the Board/Universities other than P.S.E.B and G.N.D.U are not eligible for admission.
- 6. A student is required to appear personally for the interview before the admission committee and the Principal.
- 7. The Principal reserve the right to refuse admission to any candidate if She satisfy that the refusal is in the interest of the college.
- 8. Meritorious students, outstanding players, speakers, singers shall be given due weightage in admissions provided such students produce the required certificates.
- 9. Admission to all classes of the college is provisional at the sole responsibility of the student concerned and subject to the approval of P.S.E.B/G.N.D.U. if any admission is not approved by the relevant authority for the reason that the student has failed to provide then documents in time or has concealed some information, the entire responsibility in such case will lie on the student and she will not be in entitled to any refund what so ever from the college.

For the attention of Parents and Students



Attendance:

- The students on the rolls of the college must be regular in attendance in all the subjects.
- According to GNDU norms 75% attendance in all subjects is mandatory.
- A student who remains absent from the college without leave for 10 days continuously shall be dropped from the rolls. She may be readmitted with the consent of the Principal on payment of the readmission fee of Rs. 500/- for up to 15 Days and Rs. 1000/- for upto 30 Days.
- The Shortage in attendance and the results of the pre-semester examination shall be conveyed to the parents during PT Meets.
- The parents are also required to attend the parents meet to know the performance of their ward.
- The total responsibility of having read the rules and regulations shall lie upon the parents and the students and they shall be bound by the same.
- Students shall not be allowed to leave the campus without gate pass during the working hours.

Eligibility for University Examinations

- The students are required to fulfill the following eligibility conditions for appearing in the final university examinations:
- The students have two undergo Pre-Semester exams in the month of April & October and they are required to score 35% marks in each subject.
- Clear all the dues of the college.
- Clearance-slip from library and canteen is compulsory.
